What is the 50/20/30 budget rule?


Senator Elizabeth Warren popularized the **50/20/30 budget rule** in her book "All Your Worth: The Ultimate Lifetime Money Plan." The basic **rule** is to divide after-tax income, spending **50**% on needs and **30**% on wants (not absolutely essential) while allocating **20**% to savings.
